

YEAR-END SUMMARY

*At Bear Valley Bible Institute: From January through March, we worked with 24 full-time students at Bear Valley Bible Institute International in Denver, Colorado. Then from August to October, we worked with 23 full-time students. Our work involves instruction, grading, mentoring, guidance, and counseling. While in Denver we also conduct regular gatherings at the Bear Valley house called "Ministry Moments". These gatherings include dinner, prayer, and an interview with ministers and their spouses. Courses John has taught at Bear Valley have included 1 and 2 Thessalonians/Philippians, Bible Geography, Church History, Divided Kingdom, and Biblical Counseling. I also wrote an extensive manuscript for a chapter in the Bear Valley lectureship on the book of Psalms.

*We worked with various US congregations for preaching appointments, ladies' days, gospel meetings, teacher training, and marriage seminars. Those places included San Marcos, Texas; Pigeon Forge TN; Severville TN; Gatlinburg TN; Richmond, KY; Bowling Green, KY; Oklahoma City, OK; Denver, CO; Tilton, NH; and Dripping Springs, TX.

*Working abroad, I preached in several locations in Israel as well as Greece and Italy. In the month of March, we led a group of 37 on a 12 day study program in Israel. This group was made up of various preachers, teachers, and Christians from various states in the US. In October we led and taught 56 individuals on a study program and tour to numerous places associated with the history of the early church and the life of the apostle Paul.

- •Carla continues her work as the Dean of Women at the Bear Valley Bible Institute. She administrates the daily scripture writing program called *Write on my Heart Every Word*. This year she spoke at several ladies' days, at Focal Point in San Marcos, TX, taught two classes at Bear Valley Bible Institute in Denver, CO; spoke at the "Come Fill Your Cup" retreat in Madill, OK and at Polishing the Pulpit. She also continues to co-host the popular women's podcast called "Looking Up" alongside Kathy Pollard. She regularly mentors and counsels with many women.
- •We released five New Bible Land Passages Connection Videos. The titles for those are as follows: "A Temple to Yahweh and His Wife?"; "Where a Sermon Changed the World"; "Gideon's 300: Battle for the Ages; How Did God Work in Joppa?"; and "Salt Sea: Finding the Dead Sea in the Bible". We also continue to work on the five-part series called "The Temple: Then and Now", and are anticipating its release early next year.
- •We've been so blessed by the expertise of Brian Ketchem, who overhauled and improved our website. He and his wife, Shannon, helped facilitate and coordinate our study tours. We look forward to our continued fellowship!
- •We counseled with several couples and individuals, including couples and families in ministry who were in crises. We have also written for several publications including a series of short articles that will appear in the 2024 Daily Devotional Book produced by the Jenkins Institute.
